Membership & Credentials. Larry Lindstrom moved that the High Sierra Rodeo Association (HSRA) be moved back to Member Association status. Motion passed by a voice vote.

Previous Minutes. Ed Barry moved to approve the minutes from November 8th and 11th 2007. Motion passed by a voice vote.

Financial Statements. Roger Courtemanche moved to approve the November and December (2007) and January (2008) financials. Motion passed by a voice vote.

Executive Board Reports.

President. Brian Helander deferred his report to later in the meeting.

Vice President. Andrew Goodman submitted a written report. He briefly reported that he had met with LSGRA in New Orleans regarding the royalty competition and that Mr. IGRA Gary Rushton had already met his financial obligations.

Secretary. Larry Lindstrom submitted a written report and spoke on the 2008 rodeo rulebooks.

Administrative Assistant. Tommy Channel reminded everyone to keep his or her membership lists current. He also asked that added insured be turned in as soon as possible.

Trustees Committee Chair. Ray Ostmann announced that the trustees meeting would follow immediately after the board meeting. The EPRB meeting would be postponed until Friday, May 23rd in Oklahoma City.

Committee Reports.

Animal Issues. Jim Mitchell submitted a written report with no action items.

Contestant Liaison. Ty Teigen resigned as committee chair upon being elected as CGRA President. Rob Somers volunteered to be the new committee chair.

Convention. Jay Field reported that 20% of the room block has already been reserved for the New Orleans Marriott. His report has been included in the revised committee reports.

Larry Lindstrom reported that he has visited both the New Orleans Marriott and the Toronto Marriott Bloor Yorkville in the past month and both are great properties. With taxes, the room in New Orleans comes to approximately \$115 and the room in Toronto comes to \$135.

Corporate Sponsors. Brian Helander spoke on behalf of the committee. Do we, as an organization, want to consult a marketing firm or rather a professional fundraiser? Jim Mitchell suggested that after Barry Luke revises the sponsorship package that we, as board members, have a training session and learn how to sell ourselves.

Roger moved for IGRA to engage a fundraising professional. After discussion, Roger withdrew his motion. Brian Rogers moved to direct the Executive Committee to solicit proposals from fundraising professionals to be presented at the next board meeting in Oklahoma City for consideration. Motion passed by a voice vote.

A 15-minute break was taken at 11:30 am.

Ken Brown gave a presentation about Melaleuca, which distributes over 400 products that are both environmentally and child safe. They also claim to maintain a 95% membership rate. IGRA would pay \$29 to enter the program and each individual member would also pay \$29 to become a member and then purchase the products.

Dance. Ernie Bowers had no report, but spoke on the direction of the dance committee.

Hall of Fame. Bob Pimentel directed everyone to the application on the Web site. Applications would be considered in Oklahoma City.

Rodeo Resources–University. Brian Rogers touched on some housekeeping issues.

Lunch was taken from 12:15 until 1:25 pm.

Judges. Amy Griffin submitted a written report with no action items.

Internet Technology. Frank Harrell submitted a written report with no action items. He reported that he has placed an RSS feed on the Web site as well as Google Earth place marks for all rodeo venues.

Marketing. Brian announced that only one resume had been submitted for the Marketing & Public Relations chair. Roger moved for Shaun Sewell to fill the IGRA Marketing/PR position. Discussion was that Shaun's background was in marketing. Motion passed by a voice vote.

Membership. Larry submitted a written report with no action items.

Merchandising & Vendors. Mary Arbuckle presented a written report, which has been included in the revised committee reports. Brian Rogers moved to approve Mary's proposal as presented. Motion passed by a voice vote.

A 15–minute break was taken at 1:30 pm.

Finals Rodeo. Bob Pimentel reported that the committee's recommendation was to conduct a contestant survey of certified officials at the Fort Worth, Fort Lauderdale, Palm Springs, and Denver rodeos with the results to be presented at the Chicago board meeting. Member Support Fund Ad Hoc Committee. Mary Arbuckle presented a form that contestants could fill out and submit to IGRA for consideration. The form passed by a voice vote.

Merchant Accounts. Larry reminded everyone that merchant accounts that were already set up were LinkPoint, Authorize.net, and PayPal Pro. All others would need to be programmed.

Logo Requirements. The question was raised on what logos are required for 2008. Only the IGRA and LOGO logos are required on Web sites and printed material.

Insurance. The Executive Committee presented their recommendation for the insurance point system (see attached). The recommendation passed by a voice vote.

Melaleuca. Roger moved to join with Melaleuca as a fundraising effort. After discussion, Roger withdrew his motion. Linda Frazier moved to empower the Executive Board to investigate the opportunity and report back in Oklahoma City. Motion passed by a voice vote.

IGRA Logo. Bill Chapman moved that GSGRA be allowed to use the IGRA logo on GLAC T-shirts. Motion passed by a voice vote.

President's Report. Brian reported on the current status of the IGRA Travel Store. He reminded everyone that 40% of the commission goes to IGRA. Linda moved to drive this commitment from the associations. Motion passed by a voice vote.

Mary moved to make the IGRA travel logo mandatory on all Web sites and/or rodeo-related material within 90 days grandfathering material in production. Motion passed by a voice vote.

Member Support Fund. Discussion mainly involved where funds were coming from and where they are going. It was suggested that the committee come with a plan to the OKC meeting.

The meeting was recessed at 1:38 pm and reconvened at 1:52 pm.

ASGRA reminded of their rodeo September 5–7 and their new hotel in the suburbs.

ARGRA reminded of their rodeo July 27–29.




Announcements.

Royalty

The 2008 IGRA Royalty Team and I met at the Roadrunner Regional Rodeo in Phoenix. At this meeting, we discussed plans for covering all IGRA sanctioned rodeos, University, Convention, and Finals. We also brainstormed what the schedule for the 2009 Royalty Competition in New Orleans might look like.

The Royalty Team began fundraising immediately after being crowned and sashed in Denver, and has raised \$1608. Gary Rushton has completed his minimum fundraising requirements.

IGRA Royalty Competition in New Orleans

In January, I met with the LSGRA Board (along with Larry Lindstrom and Tommy Channel) to discuss Convention and how the IGRA Royalty Competition could fit with an already hectic Convention schedule.

It was decided that the competition registration would be held on the evening of Wednesday, October 29. All portions of the Royalty Competition would take place on Thursday, October 30. On Friday, October 31, the winners' names will be announced, along with 2008 Royalty Step Downs and the celebration of the 10 Year Anniversary Royalty. The schedule may need to be altered if we have a large number of contestants.

IGRA and Rainbow Visions

At the request of the IGRA President, I have continued the relationship with Rainbow Vision as they work on a new type of sponsorship with IGRA. National Marketing and Sales Director Jane Steinberg has indicated an interest in sponsoring a contestant this year. Although no budget for has been approved by the company, Rainbow Visions is also interested in ads in the following cities/areas: Illinois, New York/New Jersey/Connecticut, California, Washington, New Mexico, Texas, Colorado, Kansas/Missouri. More details will be forthcoming when budget appropriations are completed.

IGRA University

As a new instructor at IGRA University, I spent a tremendous amount of time preparing new course materials for three University classes. In an effort to make the courses new and fresh, new course outlines were developed, as well as new materials for students. Courses will be full of information that will help both potential titleholders and current titleholders be successful.

Special attention was paid to all details of the competition. Students will be actively engaged and will leave University with ideas they can implement as soon as they get home.

One of my goals was to create a list of Horsemanship Coaches that could be a reference for those candidates who may not know how to begin the horsemanship process. With the help of Janet Jenkins, we have compiled a list that will be distributed to royalty and association Trustees.


