Secretary. Larry Lindstrom submitted a written report with no action items.

Treasurer. David Hill submitted a written report highlighting current Accounts Receivable.

Administrative Assistant. Tommy Channel reported that inclement weather insurance could be obtained from Kaliff Insurance Co.

Trustees Chair. Bill Chapman announced that the Trustees meeting would follow immediately after the close of the board meeting.

### **Committee Reports.**

Animal Issues. Kelly Peebles reported that Jay Beck had created a video on what to look for in rodeo livestock. Regarding the EHV-1, the incubation period was over and no new cases had been reported. A link to the U.S. Department of Agriculture would be helpful in the future and to avoid confusion among rodeo producers and contestants.

Archives. Brian Rogers submitted a written report with no action items.

Auditors, Secretaries, & Scorekeepers. The committee would be recommending one new scorekeeper, Ed LaBrash, in the Trustees meeting.

Budget. David Hill submitted updated budgets for IGRA, Dance, Finals, and University for both 2010 and 2011.

Community Outreach. The committee submitted a written report with a completed schedule for the months April through June and YTD monies raised by each team member.

Dance. Andrew Goodman would like the dance competition be held in the hotel lobby. The room has a lot of glass windows, high ceilings, and a bar!

Health & Safety. Linda Frazier thanked David Hill for helping gather statistics on Junior Bull Riding in 2011 versus Steer Riding in 2010.

Judges. Michael Lentz submitted a written report and would be recommending to the Trustees that one person be allowed to enter the student–judging program.

Rodeo Rules. It was reported that Chuck Browning is busy working on changes for 2012.

Social Media. A Finals Rodeo page is now up on Facebook.

University. Patrick Terry reported that the IGRA merchandise had completed a 2–year cycle. He is in need of 25<sup>th</sup> WGRF items. University netted \$2,709.28 and the dance competition \$149, combined just shy of the \$3K goal.

Women’s Outreach. The question was asked if this committee was producing a flyer?

WGRF. The committee met earlier in the day and reported that marketing efforts are underway in the Dallas–Fort Worth area.

**Old Business.** The agenda items were covered under the President’s report.

**New Business.**

Annual Convention. Bill Chapman reported that GSGRA held a meeting in San Francisco and made sub–committee appointments. One of their immediate tasks is working on transportation from the Hilton Hotel in Mission Valley up to the Hillcrest entertainment district. GSGRA also has a suite raffle at \$10 per ticket or \$20 for 3 tickets.

Rodeo Approvals. Of the four applications submitted, the Treasurer reminded everyone that no settlement sheet from FGRA has been received. Linda Frazier moved to approve their rodeo application contingent on the settlement sheet and check being received by July 31<sup>st</sup>. The motion failed due to lack of a second.

Linda moved to approve the rodeo application for Phoenix the weekend of February 17–19, 2012. The motion passed by a voice vote.

Linda moved to approve the rodeo application for Texas the weekend of March 2–4, 2012. The motion passed by a voice vote.

Linda moved to approve the rodeo application for Palm Springs the weekend of May 4–6, 2012. The motion passed by a voice vote.

Linda Frazier moved to approve the FGRA rodeo application contingent on the settlement sheet and check being received by July 31<sup>st</sup>. Bill Chapman seconds the motion for sake of discussion. After debate, Gary Eddy called for the question and passed by a voice vote. The motion to approve the rodeo application failed by a voice vote.

**Announcements.**

CGRA welcomed everyone to the board meeting and rodeo.

TGRA is excited about having the finals rodeo at the Watt Arena in Fort Worth.

GSGRA invited everyone to San Francisco the weekend of September 9–11, 2011.

AGRA reported that their bills are paid, despite the bad weather back in February.

MGRA has moved their hotel to the Westport area of Kansas City near the bars.

NMGRA invited everyone to the Zia Rodeo in Santa Fe.

ASGRA would be making a decision in 2 months on whether to continue as an association.

NGRA's BigHorn Rodeo had small attendance but made \$10K.

ILGRA invited everyone to the Windy City Rodeo the weekend of August 19–21, 2011.

ARGRA thanked everyone who attended their rodeo last weekend.

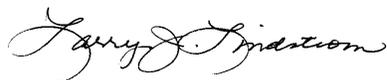
MIGRA invited everyone up to Detroit the weekend of July 22–24 for RodeoFest 2011.

Approval of Minutes. Pierre Cadieux moved to approve the minutes from Fort Lauderdale, Little Rock, and Las Vegas. The motion passed by a voice vote.

Bill Chapman questioned the checklist from the Oklahoma City rodeo. Why was #26 regarding the Finish Flag Judge's horse changed from a "No" to a "Yes" to avoid a fine? Did the stock contractor not provide a ride-able horse for finish flagging or was the judge assigned to the event not able to ride the horse and thus placed in the spectator stands? In the future, Judges need to be reassigned after consulting with the Trustees present.

Ray Ostmann moved to approve the minutes from OKC. The motion passed by a voice vote.

Certifications. Ron Trusley requested that Ed LaBrash (GWGRA) be made a certified scorekeeper and the recommendation passed by a voice vote.

Michael Lentz requested that Clint Coil (ARGRA) be allowed to enter the student-judging program and the recommendation passed by a voice vote.

### **New Business.**

Where did ARGRA publish their variance for using cows versus junior bulls? The reference is Rodeo Rule I, Number 14. Consensus was to post variances on the association's Web site rather than the IGRA Web site.

What defines a calf? Some stock contractors are bringing calves that are 400–500 pounds. After discussion, it was established that a calf is less than 6 months and 200–250 lbs.

According to Rule X, Number 26, all certified officials must stay 30 minutes after the completion of each performance. What about the ambulance? This rule needs further clarification at convention.

Some stock contractors have a different definition of junior bulls. It was suggested to change the following, junior bulls (novice bulls), in the next rulebook.

Gary Eddy asked about new Trustee orientation. Bill Chapman said he is working on a seminar for University. Gary also asked about using polls via the Yahoo group, are they valid, or do they violate California Open Meeting laws?

Gene Fraikes said that rodeo reviews regarding timing have no bearing on the rules. However, these reviews can be taken for education purposes only.

Gene asked if variances listed on the rodeo application are approved with the rodeo application and the answer is yes.

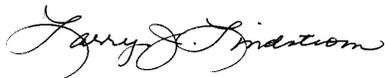
Doug Graff proposed that an association providing a Trustee who does X number of items during their term, such as attending a certain percentage of the four board and Trustee meetings.

Secretary's Report

International Awards. In my last report, I stated that nominations for the international awards would be accepted through the end of the board meeting on Friday. If there are more than 5 nominations per award, I will put them on a ballot via the [IGRABOD] group and set the voting deadline 30 days after. I have copied the description for each of the following 2 awards.

Section 5. International Award. This award is to recognize those members of IGRA who have made contributions to IGRA worthy of special recognition. This contribution can be in any of the activities that IGRA encompasses. The Board of Directors selects the recipients of this award. IGRA will cover the cost of no more than five (5) awards.

Section 6. Trustees' Award. This award is to recognize those contestants of IGRA who have exhibited excellence in the standards exemplified in the Code of Ethics and Sportsmanship. The Trustees select the recipients of this award. IGRA will cover the cost of no more than five (5) awards.

Appreciation Awards. Submissions will be accepted up through October 1<sup>st</sup>. A reminder that these awards are intended for **non-members**.

Section 8. Appreciation Award. This award is for non-members of IGRA who have made significant contributions to the association and is a means of providing a formal "thank you." This award may be given by the Officers, Directors, Trustees, Committee Chairs, or other official representatives of IGRA with the approval of the Board of Directors. IGRA will cover the cost of no more than two (2) awards per Member Association.

Membership Renewals for 2012. Tuesday, September 13<sup>th</sup> is the 60-day cutoff date for Annual Convention. This also means that all bylaw, standing rule, and rodeo rule changes need to be in to their respective chairs in **9 weeks**. This is also the date that all Member Association renewals are due to me.

2012 Rodeo Approvals. Rodeos to be held after May 12, 2012 must be approved at convention in San Diego. Please have your applications to me by November 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Section 7. Rodeos shall be sanctioned by the Board of Directors. A majority vote of the board will be required to sanction a rodeo. Sanctioning of a rodeo must occur:

- A. At least six (6) months prior to the planned rodeo date, AND
- B. Before the beginning of the prior year's annual convention.
- C. Rodeo application must be approved at a regularly scheduled board meeting.
- D. Rodeo application must be available for review no less than 7 days prior to sanctioning.

And finally, please submit your alternates to the IGRABOD group prior to all upcoming rodeos and board meetings.

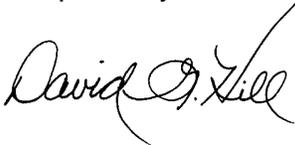
