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

IGRA Secretary's Report
Friday – May 06, 2016

This has been a very busy four months after taking office on January 1. We have had five Executive Board Meetings; four of which were conference calls. I have participated in all of these meetings except for one during which time I was in flight.

I continue trying to obtain appropriate information to set up appropriate yahoo groups. Until everyone is included in their respective group or groups, I will continue using email to ensure delivery of all correspondence.

CSGRA has asked us to put March 23-25 on the 2018 Tentative Event Schedule for their rodeo.

We are seeking bids for the 2018 IGRA University. IGRA Standing Rule IV, Section 1(A) states "IGRA University shall be held within the first month of the rodeo year and may not be scheduled within seventeen (17) days of Annual Convention, Finals Rodeo, or any other IGRA-sanctioned rodeo." If your association is interested in submitting a bid, please send the bids to me by **June 20, 2016**.

Also, we are seeking bids to host the 2017 and 2018 Annual Conventions. IGRA Bylaws Article VI, Section 1, Paragraph A states "The annual convention (Annual Convention) shall be held within the last two months of the rodeo year and may not be scheduled within seventeen (17) days of IGRA University, Finals Rodeo, or any other IGRA-sanctioned rodeo." So, if your association is interested in hosting the 2017 or 2018 annual convention, please send the bids to me by **June 20, 2016**. If you need help in knowing what you should include in a bid, please let me know.

The Board of Directors has regular quarterly meetings with the last meeting held at annual convention. Usually, the first meeting is held in conjunction with IGRA University. If your association would be interested in hosting the first, second, or third quarter meeting, please send me an email. Remember the first meeting is usually held in conjunction with IGRA University, so it will likely be in Las Vegas. I would like to receive all offers by **June 20, 2016**, and I am proposing that the 2017 schedule be determined in our July 2016 board meeting in Denver.


Standing Rule XVI, Section 2 states "Nominations for all awards that will be determined by the Directors and/or Trustees must be received no later than the third regularly scheduled Board and/or Trustees meeting of the rodeo year. Nominations for the Appreciation Award must also be received no later than the third regularly scheduled Board and/or Trustees meeting of the rodeo year. The Executive Board shall determine the method for receiving nominations and process for voting." I am asking that all nominations be submitted by **June 20, 2016**. I propose if there are five or fewer nominations for the International and Trustees' Awards, all nominees will be recipients. If there are more than five nominations, ballot voting will take place in the July board and trustees' meetings.

Finally, I would like to remind you of Standing Rule XII, Section 7:
Section 7. Rodeos shall be sanctioned by the Board of Directors.

- A. At least six (6) months prior to the planned rodeo date, AND
- B. Before the beginning of the prior year's Annual Convention.
- C. Rodeo application must be approved at a regularly scheduled Board of Directors meeting.
- D. Rodeo application must be available for review no less than 14 days prior to sanctioning.
- E. All reports and monies owed to IGRA must be settled prior to sanctioning.

2017 applications for Arizona Gay Rodeo, Sunshine Stampede, A Texas Tradition Rodeo, Rodeo in the Rock, Hot Rodeo, and BigHorn Rodeo must be approved in the July 8, 2016 board meeting. Send the application to me early enough to post for review no less than 14 days prior to sanctioning. Although the Great Plains Rodeo application can be approved in the November 2016 board meeting, I must receive it early enough to post for the 14-day minimum time period for review.

**IGRA Corporate Auditor Report for IGRA BOD Meeting at the IGRA BOD Meeting in Palm Springs
May 6, 2016**

REPORT Covering January through March 2016 – Three Months Reviewed:

- Prior Report to IGRA University for the Period Ending 12/31/2015
- Reviewed January, February and March 2016
- I had full access to the books and records and related reconciliations of IGRA.
- I reviewed the January, February and March, 2016 Bank Reconciliations. They reconciled and agreed to the General Ledger.
- I reviewed the Income Statements and Balance Sheets for both months which include a comparison to the prior year. The Income on the Balance Sheets agrees to the Income on the Income Statements and Retained Earnings rolled forward appropriately.
- The Income Statements look reasonable when compared to the activity of the prior year, and activity observed in the General Ledger.
- I reviewed the General Ledger for deposit and cash expense transactions from January, February and March 2016
- There were 171 line items of deposits/expenditures. (some deposits/expenditures covered multiple lines of detail)
- Using a random number generator (found at random.org) I ran a random sample covering 10% of deposits/expenditures – rounded up (17) in the reviewed period.
- All of the deposits examined tied to the general ledger as did the expenditures in the sample of 17, one expenditure is tied to a multi-year contract for storage of the Bulls purchased from ASGRA that has annual increases that tie to the once a year notice of a price increase and not the original contract which was the base/floor price. The difference of \$6 rounded is the result of small annual price increases plus taxes. Both the deposits and the expenditures appeared to be properly supported, either by receipt or fees found on the bank statement.

I am happy to report to the IGRA Board of Directors that nothing out of the ordinary was noted.

I would like to thank our Treasurer, David Hill for his continued meticulous work.

Please note: This is an Internal Review/Audit, as prescribed by the By-Laws and is not, nor is it intended to be, an external independent audit performed in accordance with Generally Accepted Auditing Standards and accordingly no opinion is expressed on the IGRA financial statements in that respect.

Since being appointed membership chair I have worked on several facets of growing IGRA membership with not only new associations but working with existing ones to grow their members as well.

I have been made one of the moderators with the IGRA Facebook and myself & Char Duran are now added moderators with the Queens & Cowboys Facebook page as well. It would help so much if All moderators would try to get on the same page and offer the same information. What this means is that when someone asks a question on our page that the correct info is given. Please make sure to direct them to the chain of command within IGRA. Local association in their prospective area first to help grow those groups first then offer an alternative to help satisfy their need if that is not working. Facebook seems to be a great tool and we can use to our advantage.

I have answered so many questions with folks wanting to start up a new association and help direct them to info needed.

Two major things we have worked on is new women rough stock riders and interest from Mexico.

With the groups in Mexico that have expressed interest in joining with IGRA we are working on speaking with the people in charge of their very large functions all across Mexico. There has been a communication difficulty and we now have some help with that aspect. Bruce has directed and I have spoken with Marco Polo as you know him that had offered to speak and help with the language barrier. As for their interest it looks as if some will be coming to finals in Vegas where we hope to speak more on a face to face level. More to follow on Mexico.

Late last year I was contacted by Char Duran about Texas and the Ft Worth Stock Show that was happening in January. The Cowboys of Color Rodeo known as the "Black Rodeo" had opened up and was offering women's bull riding at their rodeos at the stock show. Char and a few other IGRA women bull riders were going to ride in January. Char asked me if I would come and help the girls and herself by helping behind the chutes in tying them in. I agreed and went to the event. An amazing thing happened when I arrived. I met some women bull riders that said they were having a tough time finding places to ride where they were welcome. They would most of the time have to go ride against men and ride tougher stock than what fit their skill level. I asked if they had heard about IGRA and our rodeos that had its own women's events? Some had heard of us but most had not. I opened it up that we would love to have them at our rodeos. Through many texts, Facebook posts and messages and several phone calls I am proud to say that 4 women showed up to the TGRA Texas rodeo and competed in women's Bull & Steer riding. They joined IGRA associations and competed and I am ecstatic to say that 2 of them covered their rides and now are headed to finals. Not only was it the 4 women but one brought her boyfriend and he rode bulls & steers as well. They are so excited to find IGRA and our rodeos that they have told others and it

looks like those 4 and 2 new ladies will be competing in OK City. Very Happy!
 Also it seems as if the Mississippi group has joined forces with the Cotton States group and will helping them with an upcoming rodeo there. Many thanks to all that have helped and mostly to Bruce Gros for taking the time to be a part of rodeo not just the office side. Great to see his face at our events.
