WAYNE JAKINO SCHOLARSHIP

GUIDELINES

These guidelines were developed to aid IGRA and IGRA University with the awarding of scholarship funds out of the Wayne Jakino Scholarship Fund.

- 1) A minimum of \$1,000 must be maintained in the fund. Scholarships may only be awarded from monies in excess of the \$1,000 base amount.
- 2) An applicant must be a member of an IGRA recognized association, in good standing, for at least one (1) calendar year.
- 3) Applications for the scholarship funds should be submitted to the selection committee no later than 60 days prior to the beginning of IGRA University.
- 4) The Selection committee should be made up of the Chancellor, Dean of the Announcing school, one member of the IGRA Executive Board—designated by the President.
- 5) Applicant may apply as many times as they wish, but will only be eligible to receive the Scholarship once every three years unless the Selection Committee believes there are extenuating circumstances, no other applicants, or an excess of funds.
- 6) Recipients must attend all of the Announcing series (or as offered) as well as other classes that might be applied towards the "Recognized Announcer" program as defined in the IGRA bylaws and rodeo rules. Recipients may attend other courses as they see fit.
- 7) Scholarship award amount shall not be less than the required tuition and not more than \$250 over tuition amount (to be used towards hotel, meals, and/or transportation to and from IGRA University)
- 8) The Selection Committee may award as many or as few scholarships as they see fit, providing the necessary funds are available. If the fund is \$1,000 or less no Scholarships will be awarded that year.
- 9) Criteria for selection should be based on, but not limited to:
 - a) Demonstrated sincerity for learning to announce/keeping "Recognition"
 - b) Persuasiveness of application and other required documents (letters, essays, references, etc)
 - c) Recommendations (not required, but should be taken into consideration)
 - d) Past IGRA and local association levels of participation
